AutoCAD can be used as a vector-based 2D drafting program, or in conjunction with a 3D modeler for creating 3D drawings, for creating a wide variety of technical drawings, most commonly in 2D for large scale architectural and engineering projects. The AutoCAD symbol system in particular makes it easy to create two-dimensional drawings, but three-dimensional drawings (of solid models) can also be created with a combination of the drawing tools and 3D modeling. AutoCAD uses a project file format. This

allows a project to be saved with all the entities and all the drawing data in the same file, which enables the drawing and entities to be modified independently of each other. This means that it is possible to update a drawing without having to repaint the entities to retain the previously made changes. It also means that you can make changes to the entities without having to redraw everything, provided you have saved the project file before the changes were made. This is also true of the AutoCAD table of contents feature. You can create tables of contents using drawing objects or block attributes, and you

can have them saved in a separate file if you wish. There are also system-wide TOCs which show the drawing objects, blocks, entities, attributes, groups, layers, and auxiliary files of a drawing. These TOCs can be created, modified, and saved at any time. History

AutoCAD 1.0, released in December 1982, was based on Microsoft's MDAC (Microsoft Dynamic Array Compiler) programming language, which ran on an Intel 8086 microprocessor running at 8 MHz. Autodesk began development of the first versions of AutoCAD in 1981. The name AutoCAD is an abbreviation of the

term "Automatic Computer-Aided Design". AutoCAD was originally written by engineers and industrial designers at Autodesk, and was designed to increase design efficiency by automating the repetitive tasks associated with drafting. The first version was released in 1982 as a desktop version for microcomputers with a color display and 64 Kbyte (Kibibyte) of RAM. The original AutoCAD had a light blue interface, and contained a font editor and a simple drawing window. The font editor could be used to convert between many different font formats, and the

drawing window was used to draw geometry and draw text. The font editor was actually a fork of the font editor in the software program Am

Hedley Woodland is a London woodlover and proud father of three. We all love the outdoors and all our local parks provide abundant wildlife, including several different species of bats. We've visited many of these, but there's one in particular that's always been particularly special to us. If you look south from where we live in Watford, you'll see this large wood off Farrington Road. Although not exactly a wood it's rather large and has plenty of interest. On a day in May 2005 we were lucky to see two bat species foraging there. A

few of the lanes are very narrow, making it easy to get stuck, but there's still a good amount of movement of vehicles. We arrived by car, but we've also seen them on foot. They're in a marshy area that's surrounded by long wet grass, so they're not far from a stream and are able to move between the land and the water when they need to. These species are the Bonelli's bat, which is a form of common pipistrelle, and a Pond bat, which is in fact another name for common myotis. Bonellis eat large amounts of insects, but only catch those flying over them, whereas common myotis will eat whatever's around

and catch insects that come to them - including flying towards the bat. The two of them weren't quite in the same place and they moved about quite quickly, but they were both very easy to see and have been seen before. We've seen other pipistrelle species too, such as soprano pipistrelle and the rare Spanish and greater horseshoe bats. It's very common for pipistrelle species to be in London parks and woodlands, but they're normally in small groups of less than ten bats. We're very lucky to have a local park where these species have been recorded, but there are some places where they're quite common.

These include the Kennet and Avon rivers in Berkshire, Fleet Pond in Buckinghamshire, Banstead Weir in Surrey and the River Thames near Kew Bridge in Middlesex. Similar to the pond bat, they also like to hang out in tree trunks and will move a lot between trees - always a good thing to spot. You can see the birds in this video: We don't think the pond bat is common in our area, but we have seen it quite often
